

To the Parents of Central ISD students:

The District is required by federal law to notify you and obtain your consent or denial (opt-out) for your child to participate in certain school activities. The activities include a student survey, analysis, or evaluation that concerns one or more of the following eight areas, known as "protected information surveys."

1. Political affiliations or beliefs of the student or student's parent;
2. Mental or psychological problems of the student or student's family;
3. Sex behavior or attitudes;
4. Illegal, antisocial, self-incriminating, or demeaning behavior;
5. Critical appraisals of others with whom respondents have close family relationships;
6. Legally recognized privileged relationships, such as with lawyers, doctors, or ministers;
7. Religious practices, affiliations, or beliefs of the student or parents; or
8. Income, other than as required by law to determine program eligibility.

This requirement also applies to the collection, disclosure, or use of student information for marketing purposes ("marketing surveys"), and certain physical exams and screenings.

Following are activities requiring parental notice and consent or opt-out for the 2006–2007 school year. Please note that this notice and authority to consent transfer from parent to student when the student reaches 18 or is an emancipated minor under state law.

Grades: 8

Activity: Search Institute's Student Resources and Assets

Summary: This is an anonymous survey that identifies the presence or absence of the Five Promises among youth, which include: ongoing relationships with caring adults, safe places and structured activities during non-school hours, a healthy start for a healthy future, marketable skills through effective education, and opportunities to serve. This survey also identifies the 40 developmental asset building blocks of human development that are known to help protect youth from high-risk behavior and to help enhance school success and other forms of thriving behavior.

Consent: A parent must sign and return this consent form no later than September 1, 2007 so that your child may participate in this survey.

Opt-out: Contact the jr. high office at 936-853-2115 no later than September 1, 2007 if you do not want your child to participate in this activity.
